St Drostan's is a home run by Aberdeenshire Council in Old Deer for elderly people who need residential care. The council have decided to close the home and to compel the residents to move to other care homes. Forced moves will stress the residents and increase the risk of mortality. Until the threat of closure St Drostan's Care Home was a happy community. The excellence of the care provided has been officially recognized by the Care Commission Review of St Drostan's carried out in 2004/2005.

Perhaps it is unrealistic to expect to save the home, but it is not unrealistic to campaign for the home to be kept open until alternative local accommodation has been developed.

Keep St Drostan's open in the meantime.
